The annual PoppyScotland appeal has launched, for Remembrance Sunday on 11<sup>th</sup> November. They provide help and assistance to veterans from many conflicts, and this year is particularly special for the charity as it is the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the ending of fighting during the First World War. Teams of senior pupils will be coming to KAT classes to sell poppies – please give as generously as you are able to. If you want a poppy there is a minimum donation of 50p required. If 40 people donate 50p we can help provide a homeless veteran with shelter for one night. If 500 of us donate 50p we could provide shelter for one night for 12 veterans.
