Ameer Al-Gumaei (**Tay House**) - He is working hard to earn his black belt in Taekwondo. He has blue belt now. Every Sunday, he volunteers as a librarian at a weekend school. He is also participating in the Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's Award programme.

Sophia West (**Tay House**) - Sophia is a member of Edinburgh Diving Club and competed last weekend in the Scottish National Age Group Diving Championships in Aberdeen. She won Gold Scottish Champion for 3m springboard (age group) and Bronze 1m springboard (age group).

Stanisław Szaloki (**Dee House**) - In April, Staś took part in a swimming competition in the Royal Commonwealth. He got a silver medal in the 50 metres backcrawl swim skills 4 WSC/DSC final and a bronze one in the 50 metres breaststroke swim skills 4 WSC/DSC final.
