School Closure Days



Further to the e-mail sent to families in May, this is a reminder of our school closure dates in order to facilitate the move to our new campus:

The final day for pupils is **WEDNESDAY 24th JUNE** (school ends at 3.30pm)

The 'staff only' closure dates are:

- **Wednesday 12th August**



The first day of term for pupils after the summer break is **Thursday 13th August**.

Liberton High School Uniform



Top Half – Outer/long-sleeved Layer

Either

- Plain black (no logos) jumper, hoodie, zipper, sweatshirt, cardigan (*from any shop*)

Or

- Black LHS logo sweatshirt, hoodie, zipper (*from www.border-embroideries.co.uk*)

Top Half - Inner layer

Either

- White shirt and LHS school tie

Or

- Plain black or white T-shirt or Polo Shirt (no logos) from any shop, or LHS logo polo shirt or T shirt (*from www.border-embroideries.co.uk*)

Cropped tops which do not fully cover a pupil's midriff, and skintight vest tops with thin straps, are not appropriate and will not be permitted

Bottom Half

- Plain black leggings (not seethrough)
- Plain black skirt
- Plain black trousers
- Plain black joggers
- Plain black shorts (no hotpants)
- Plain black jeans (not ripped)

These items should have no logos

Footwear

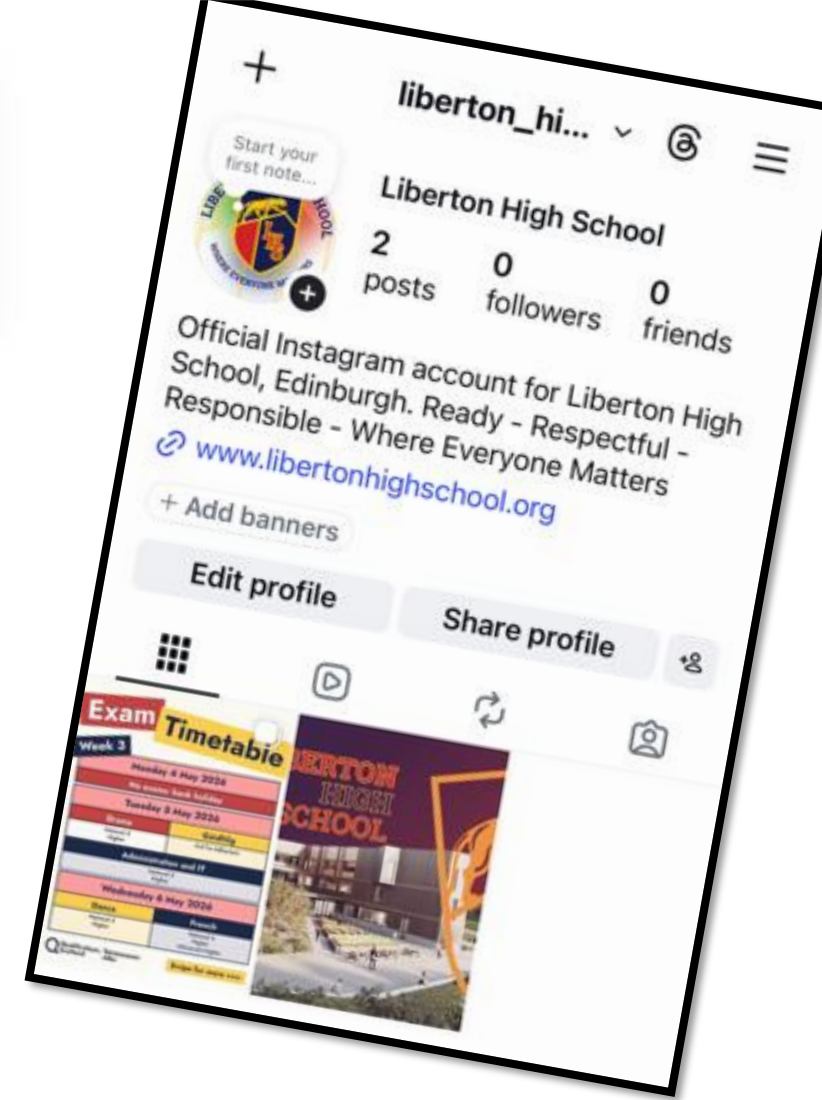
- Comfortable trainers or shoes with a closed toe (no flip flops or sandals)
